INTRODUCTION TO DRAMA (ages 4-8)

In Introduction to Drama, students will develop and improve creative skills through a variety of theatre experiences. Younger children are given opportunities to apply their imaginations in theatre activities to perform with self-confidence, participate collaboratively, and enhance problem-solving abilities. Activities include: creative play, pantomime, improvisation, character development, and story dramatization.

This class is ideal for:

- ✓ Students in preschool through 3rd grade
- ✓ Emerging readers
- ✓ Those who are new to acting and performing and want to improve their skills



ACTING (ages 9 and up)

In Acting, students will practice creating believable characters through facial expressions, body movement and gestures, and voice. Older students are given opportunities to perform scenes and monologues for practice and for performance. Activities include: improvisation, acting exercises, scene work (for stage and film), and competition/audition preparation.

This class is ideal for:

- ✓ Students wishing to compete in acting at Access Broadway or prepare for auditions
- ✓ Those seeking to improve their performance skills and stage presence
- ✓ Anyone wanting to boost confidence and improve their public speaking skills

Any Acting student may compete in the Access Broadway competition on Feb. 9-11, 2018, however, this is not compulsory. It is **not** required that the Acting student be a member of the Sharper Image Dance competition team in order to compete in this competition. In short, the Sharper Image Acting Troupe is separate from the Sharper Image Dance Competition team. Students may compete in the following categories:

- Monologue (one actor- comedy or drama)
- Duet/Trio Acting (2-3 actors- comedy or drama)
- Ensemble Acting (4-15 actors- comedy or drama)
- Broadway Vocal (solo ballad or up-tempo)
- Broadway Show Group (4-15 performers- musical theatre)



In most cases, performance rehearsals will be held during class. Should additional rehearsals be required, the group will be charged a fee of \$30 a half hour. Also, Mrs. Beth is available for any of her students wishing to perfect their performance at the same rate of \$30 a half hour.
